- (b) University of Calgary PLM Program.

University of Calgary PLM Program applicants must be enrolled in the final year of studies.

- 2. Enclose transcripts of all post-secondary marks as well as your PLM Program transcripts with your application. If your transcripts are unavailable at the time of application, please forward as soon as possible. Applications must be received in Calgary by October 15th and will not be reviewed until the Committee has received your transcripts.
- 3. In the event your application is approved for a scholarship, you will be required to submit proof of full-time enrollment in the applicable year of any of the above programs..
- 4. Please return the application to the address shown above. Note it should be to the attention of "Chairman, Scholarship Trust Fund". Please indicate "Personal & Confidential" on the envelope.
- 5. The CAPL Scholarship Trust Fund Committee has implemented an interview procedure and awards the CAPL Scholarships through this procedure. The Committee plans to increase the requirements for a scholarship from academic standings to include financial need, communication skills, volunteer and extra curricular activities. The interview dates will be arranged at a later time and communicated with the program directors.
