**On-line Land Administration Certificate for Winter 2011**



Olds College is proud to offer its popular Land Administration program using a new delivery system. This ten course program will be available via on-line delivery at [eCampusAlberta.ca](http://eCampusAlberta.ca) beginning February 1, 2011.

Students can choose to enroll full-time and complete the program in eight months or enroll as a part-time student and complete the certificate at their own pace over 5 years.

The program is ideal for people presently working who want to upgrade their skills in surface land administration or who want to prepare for a new career.

Graduates of the program find employment in the fast paced offices of organizations in the energy, utilities, environment, and transportation sectors.
