- Functional understanding of RTX accounting and financial reporting systems.
- In-depth understanding of related legal processes.
- In-depth understanding of commercial/banking issues relating to bonds, guarantees, securities, powers of attorney, caveats, statutory declarations and mortgages.
- In-depth understanding of land administration systems throughout their jurisdictions.
- Exposure to engagement with NGOs and external stakeholders.
- Exposure to multi-country, multi-commodity, exposure to multi-disciplines.
