ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

(a) Committee members agree to volunteer for a two year term and to attend scheduled meetings (usually monthly). Monthly commitment is approximately 4 hours.

(b) Committee members are responsible for the production and development of article and feature ideas and the corresponding approaches to prospective authors.

(c) Committee members may be paired up (a senior and a more junior Land Negotiator) to operate in smaller subgroups in the production and development of articles and features.

(d) Committee members are responsible to ensure the timely submission of articles and features to the Features Content Editor and the Publication Designer.

(e) Committee members also assist with the monthly editing of The Negotiator prior to the edition going to print.

(f) Committee members are encouraged to provide ideas and support the ongoing evolution of The Negotiator in the fundamental elements of layout, publication structure and editorial direction.
